From gnarly 40 year old bush vines - an elegant national treasure from dry grown coastal vineyards. Crushed for flavour not colour, this 40 year old unirrigated bush vine wine sucks only from the rocks underground. Bright, expressive, gently savoury on the nose

Plenty of joy in this delightful blend of old vine Chenin and young Viognier. Vibrant and aromatic with delicious generous fresh apricot, white peach and hints of jasmine on the nose. On the palate it has tight, white, fleshy stone fruit with a balancing sandy texture. Bright acidity and minerality delivers a delicious balance.
